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# 1. Basic Information

### 2. Poster

### Poster Announcement

The apc|m conference will be held as a **on-site** conference.

All poster presenter on site in Hamburg will give their presentation live in front of the audience.

There will be a **poster announcement** at Tuesday afternoon. Every poster presenter will have the opportunity to present the tenor of his poster using **one slide** for about **2 minutes**.

Please use the **poster announcement template** to prepare this one slide and show clearly:

- Poster title and Poster number
- Authors and affiliation
- Motivation / Purpose of your contribution
- Description of the approach
- Innovation of this approach
- Achieved results of your work

#### Your Poster for the Poster session

The purpose of a poster presentation is to use a display (poster board) to summarize the study described in your abstract. The dedicated poster session allows the presenter (that's you) the opportunity to discuss your work and answer questions.

You must bring your own hard copy of the poster with you to the conference. Poster stripes will be available which can be used to paste your presentation to the poster board.

On the poster board, that will be provided for you, a **portrait oriented** poster of **A0 size** (84 cm x 119 cm) can be placed easily.


Please, do not use single A4 or US letter size sheets to conduct your poster!

To be recognized as poster author, it is helpful, to **include a photo of yourself in your poster**.

Please mind: The authors are requested to be available at their poster for questions and answers during the poster session.

Design a poster for the poster exhibition:

- Poster size A1 (portrait)
- File type: png (jpg, tif)



Your poster material will be published via download in PDF format.

### File Format

Please send your files in following formats:

- 1. One slide in PDF format for **poster announcement**, **using the poster announcement template**
- 2. Your poster files in **PDF** format for the **download**
- 3. Please use the following **file description** for your documents

Please transform your presentation into PDF format. We propose a resolution of 300dpi. Do not forget to include special fonts and check the PDF file for graphic and font faults finally.

- Poster announcement:

Tuesday, April 16, 2024 afternoon

- Poster session:

The dedicated poster session is scheduled on Tuesday afternoon, just after the poster announcement and on Wednesday in a longer break. The authors are requested to be available at their posters for Q / A.

#### - Poster teardown:

Thursday, April 18, 2024, after the end of the conference

All information presented at this meeting is considered non-confidential. No material labeled confidential or proprietary (or similarly) will be presented or provided via download!

All information presented orally will also be regarded as non- confidential.
